Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on 10.04.2026, in the similar facts and circumstances, a coordinate Bench at Principal Seat, Jodhpur in the case of **Jagdeesh Prajapat & Ors. v. State of Rajasthan & Ors.: SBCW No.8010/2026**, has passed the following order:-

"1. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that despite hub and spoke module not being implemented with Government Jawahar Lal Nehru District Hospital, Nagaur, the respondents vide office order dated 02.04.2026 (Annex.10) have decided to terminate the services of the petitioners w.e.f. 31.03.2026 while granting them liberty to secure re-employment through Krishna Lab, which is a private firm.

3. Considering the above submissions and the fact that the petitioners are working from the last more than five years and no regular appointment being made by the government, yet their services have been sought to be discontinued, this Court deems it just and proper to stay effect and operation of the order dated 02.04.2026 (Annex.10) and the respondents are directed to allow the petitioners to continue in service in the same capacity till the next date of hearing."

In view of the above, there shall be a stay on termination order dated 18.03.2026 (Annex.03) issued by the respondent No.3 and the respondents are directed to allow the petitioners to continue in service in the same capacity, on which he was discharging prior to termination order.

Issue notice to the respondents through both the process, returnable within eight weeks.

Requisites be filed within a period of two weeks.
