1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the impugned medical assessment done by the Medical Board, SMS Hospital, Jaipur at the instance of RPSC, whereby her physical disability has been assessed as 26%.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner applied for the post of State Administrative Services in pursuance of the advertisement dated 02.09.2024. Learned counsel further submits that initially in the year 2018, she was assessed with 45% disability, thereafter AIIMS Jodhpur assessed her disability as 59%. However, in terms of the directions of the RPSC, when she appeared for the physical medical examination before the Medical Board of the SMS Hospital, Jaipur, she was assessed to have 26% disability by assessment/certificate dated 22.03.2025.

3. Learned counsel further submits that there is serious variation in the assessment by the Medical Board and therefore, same cannot be accepted.
4. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner came to know about the change in category on account of the variation in the disability assessment subsequent to the declaration of result and therefore, she approached this Court after the result was declared and there is no delay on her part.
5. In view of the above, issue notice to the respondents returnable within a period of four weeks.
6. In the meanwhile, the selection process qua the post of physical disabled candidates shall remain subject to the final outcome of the writ petition, insofar as it concerns the petitioner.
