1. The present criminal miscellaneous petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of the FIR No.0152/2026 dated 07.04.2026 (Annexure-1) lodged at Police Station Vaishali Nagar, Jaipur (West), for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 305(a), 316(5) and 61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (**BNS**), 2023.

2. Mr. Anurag Shukla, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the allegations as levelled in the impugned FIR even if taken on the face of it, fails to disclose any offence being committed by the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel submits that on the contrary, a bare perusal of the allegations so levelled in the impugned FIR, reveals that the same has been filed with respect to alleged violation of the terms of the Management Services Agreement executed between Oyo Hotels and Homes Private Limited and M/s. Hotel Aqua (Annexure-2), of which, the respondent – complainant is the partner, which has a dispute resolution clause and confirms that the matter is purely of a civil nature.

4. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner has been roped in as the Director of Oyo Hotels and Homes Private Limited in the impugned FIR whereas, the status of the Director of the Oyo Hotels and Homes Private Limited as available on the website of Ministry of Corporate Affairs (Annexure-3), clearly demonstrates the fact that the petitioner is not the Director of the said company.

5. Taking note of the above, issue notices to the respondents.

6. Mr. Manvendra Singh Shekhawat, learned Public Prosecutor, appears on behalf of respondent No.1.

7. Notice be filed only for respondent No.2, returnable within eight weeks. Notice may also be sent through registered post in addition to normal process.

8. List the matter on 05.08.2026.

9. In the meanwhile, further proceedings in the impugned FIR No.0152/2026 dated 07.04.2026 (Annexure-1) shall remain stayed.
