Heard on application No.1/2026 filed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.8124/2026 and on applications No.1/2026 & 2/2026 filed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 10209/2026.

Applicant claims itself to be Residential Welfare Association and has prayed for impleadment of the applicant as party respondent to these writ petitions.

Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that only on complaint made by the applicant, the impugned action has been taken against the petitioner, therefore, petitioner is necessary party in these writ petitions.

Heard learned counsel for the applicant and perused the record.

This Court finds that in the instant writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the orders/notices issued by RIICO and RIICO has also been impleaded as party respondent.

Under these circumstances, the complainant has got no right whatsoever to seek impleadment in the instant writ petitions.

Moreso, under the circumstances, where the complainant-Welfare Association itself has filed a separate S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.9845/2026, which is also connected with these writ petitions, the applications filed by the applicant deserve to be rejected.

Accordingly, the applications are dismissed.
