- 1.** The present criminal miscellaneous petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of FIR No.0032/2026 dated 16.01.2026 (Annexure-1) lodged at Police Station Sikandra, District Dausa, for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 3 and 7 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955.
- 2.** Mr. Shashi Bhushan Gupta, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the impugned FIR has been lodged alleging embezzlement and black-marketing of 37,852.60 Kg of wheat, which has been calculated after deducting 40,174 Kg of wheat from the total amount of 78,026.60 Kg of wheat.
- 3.** Learned counsel submits that with respect to the said quantity of 40,174 Kg of wheat, an earlier FIR No.0384/2020 dated 20.09.2020 (Annexure-11) was registered in which a Final

Report No.1 dated 05.03.2021 (Annexure-12) came to be filed by the investigating agency and the said final report has also been accepted by Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Sikrai, District Dausa, vide its order dated 27.09.2023. However, for the reasons best known to the respondents, no reference has been given to the said final report.

4. Learned counsel submits that the impugned FIR refers to an alleged incident dated 18.03.2024, however, the same has been lodged on 16.01.2026 with a grave delay.

5. Taking note of the above, issue notices to the respondents.

6. Mr. Manvendra Singh Shekhawat, learned Public Prosecutor, appears on behalf of respondent No.1.

7. Notice be filed only for respondent No.2, returnable within four weeks. Notice may also be sent through registered post in addition to normal process.

8. List the matter on 15.07.2026.

9. In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall not be arrested in respect of the impugned FIR No.0032/2026 dated 16.01.2026 (Annexure-1), however, he is required to duly co-operate and participate in the investigation.
