In S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Petition No.2813/2026:-

The present criminal miscellaneous petition is filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No.452/2025 dated 13.07.2025, registered at Police Station Shipra Path, District Jaipur City (South), for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 318(2), 189(2), 115(2), 126(2), 324(4) & 331(2) of B.N.S., 2023.

Mr. Anurag Kalavatiya, learned counsel for the petitioners has brought attention of this Court to the order dated 04.08.2025 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in ***S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous (Petition) No.4508/2025***, titled as ***Pushpendra Dabas & Anr. Vs. The State of Rajasthan &***

Anr., (Annexure-7), which has been filed by the complainant/respondent No.2 seeking quashing of FIR No.453/2025 lodged by petitioner Nos.2 – Nemichand Sharma and 3 – Khushal Sharma. The order dated 04.08.2025 reads as under:-

- "1. It is a case of lodging cross FIR by petitioners and complainant against each other (FIR No.453/2025 has been lodged against the petitioners, whereas FIR No.452/2025 has been lodged by the petitioners), both of which have been registered at Police Station Shipra Path, Jaipur City (South).*
- 2. The dispute is in respect of letting out the non-converted property for commercial purpose and forceful dispossession.*
- 3. Heard.*
- 4. Issue notice to the respondent No.2-complainant.*
- 5. In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to join investigation on 25-26.08.2025 before the Investigating Officer, however, no coercive steps against them, shall be taken.*
- 6. List the matter after six weeks.*
- 7. Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to call for the investigation report."*

Issue notice to the respondents.

Learned Public Prosecutor appears on behalf of respondent No.1 – State.

Mr. Prameshwar Lal Pilania, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondent No.2.

Hence, service is complete and notice need not be filed.

Mr. Aditya Kakade, IPS, ACP Mansarovar, is also personally present before this Court today.

Taking note of the aforementioned order dated 04.08.2025, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer, however, they shall not be arrested in respect of the impugned FIR.

List the matter on 16.07.2026, on or before which, learned Public Prosecutor is directed to submit the status report in respect of both the FIRs being 452/2025 and 453/2025.

List the matter on 16.07.2026.
