Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that transaction in question qua registration of sale deed for 10 plots was entered on 16.01.2025 for an agreed consideration.

It is further submitted that *sans* filing any cancellation or taking appropriate action under the provisions of Civil Act, impugned FIR is lodged on 24.04.2025 alleging that appropriate consideration is not paid qua the transaction in question.

Furthermore, it is submitted that impugned FIR is lodged at a belated stage on false and fabricated grounds. It is further submitted that civil dispute is given a criminal colour by lodging the present FIR, which is abuse of process of law.

Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioner is wrongly and falsely implicated in the impugned FIR.

In the meantime, no coercive action/arrest shall be made qua the petitioner.
