- Instant criminal miscellaneous IInd interim bail application has been filed by the accused-petitioner Raunak S/o Lalit, arrested in connection with FIR No. 72/2025, Police Station Malpura Gate District Jaipur City (East) for the offences under sections 318(4), 319(2) of B.N.S., 2023 and under Section 66D I.T. Act.
- Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner is a student of B.C.A. Semester IV at Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur. He further submits that accused-petitioner has filed this interim bail application on the ground that examination for the said course are to be commenced on 01.07.2026 and the last exam is to be held on 04.07.2026. Learned counsel submits that the accused-petitioner had secured good marks in the previous semesters and intends to pursue his

studies. In view thereof, learned counsel for the accused-petitioner prayed that accused-petitioner be enlarged on interim bail.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the present interim bail application.

4. Considering overall facts and circumstances of the case and keeping in view the fact that the accused-petitioner is a student, this Court deems it appropriate to grant interim bail to the accused-petitioner.

5. So in view thereof, the instant IInd interim bail application of the accused-petitioner namely **Raunak S/o Lalit** is hereby allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner shall be released on interim bail from 30.06.2026 till 06.07.2026, on furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court, one of which is close family member of the accused-petitioner.

6. The accused-petitioner shall be released at 05:00 PM on 30.06.2026 and shall have to surrender on or before the concerned Jail Authorities at 01:00 PM on 06.07.2026, failing which the Jail Authorities shall report the matter.

7. Office is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court and concerned Jail Authorities through e-mail/fax, for necessary compliance.

8. List the main criminal misc. bail application after two weeks.
