The issue of non-payment/non release of pensionary benefits to petitioners in compliance of the final order passed by learned Single Judge which has been affirmed by Division Bench so also by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

As per order of learned Single Judge, pensionary benefits to petitioners including the arrears of pension with interest @ 9% p.a. were to be paid in continuity to their services in the Department of Rajasthan State Sheep and Wool Marketing Federation Ltd. wherefrom petitioners were absorbed in the Department of Animal Husbandry under the Rules of 1969.

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing on behalf of the Department of Animal Husbandry pointed out that pension to

petitioners w.e.f. date of absorption in Animal Husbandry Department has already been released and the revised PPO and GPO, in favour of petitioners have also been issued by the Department of Animal Husbandry and forwarded to the Pension Department to pay arrears of pension. Copy of revised PPO and GPO orders of petitioners have been placed on record.

Counsel for petitioners states at bar that actual payment of due pensions/arrears has not been made so far.

We are surprised that the Department of Animal Husbandry has filed a compliance report without ensuring the release of actual payment of due pension and arrears along with interest hence, we find that on face value, the compliance report is not only incomplete and vague but also misleading the Court.

Dr. Samit Sharma, Principal Secretary, Department of Animal Husbandry shall ensure actual release/payment of pension/pensionary dues/arrears with interest to the petitioners within a period of four weeks, failing which he shall file his personal affidavit and shall also remain present in person/through video conferencing before this Court.

Non-compliance shall be taken seriously.

Registrar (Judicial) shall supply a copy of this order in the office of Principal Secretary, Department of Animal Husbandry for compliance.
