Learned Advocate General submits that pursuant to order of this Court dated 04.09.2025, an affidavit of the respondent No.3 alongwith compliance report was filed on that very day and the

additional affidavit of the respondent No.3 has been filed today in the Office disclosing the details of alternative arrangements made.

Learned Advocate General is further directed to file an affidavit of the respondent No.3 giving the road map for making, at the earliest, proper and suitable arrangement of the school buildings/rooms for safe and smooth study of the children.

We also deem it just and proper to direct the Secretaries, District Legal Services Authority of the respective districts to conduct a random sample survey, especially in remote rural areas, of the existing school buildings/rooms where the studies are still going on as also of the alternative arrangements stated to be made by the respondents. The District Collectors of the respective districts shall make available to the Secretaries, a copy of the Annexure-RA-3 appended with the additional affidavit of the respondent No.3 dated 08.09.2025 on or before 12.09.2025. The inspection may be conducted in between 15.09.2025 to 18.09.2025 as per convenience and remit their report on or before the next date. The District Collectors, the Superintendents of Police and the District Education Officers of the respective districts are directed to provide all necessary logistic and other necessary support for smooth inspection.
