Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although earlier pursuant to inquiry conducted by the Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Sawai Madhopur, Rajasthan, directions were given to recover amount of alleged embezzlement from the petitioner by holding him guilty of charges, however, order dated 07.10.2005 passed by the Registrar under Section 57 of the Act of 2001 was challenged by the petitioner by way of filing revision petition under Section 107 of the Act of 2001. The revision petition was allowed vide order dated 05.11.2003, and the order passed by the Assistant Registrar after inquiry under Section 57 was quashed. Learned counsel further submits that although writ petition was preferred by the respondents against such order passed in revision petition, yet the same has also been dismissed.

Learned counsel also submits that in the meanwhile, the petitioner on attaining the age of superannuation, has retired in the year 2014. Quite abruptly without issuing any notice, or

affording opportunity of hearing vide demand letter dated 04.01.2025, the petitioner has been directed to deposit Rs.9,21,922/-.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents sought time to file reply to the writ petition.

Four weeks' time is granted to file reply to the writ petition.

In the meanwhile and till further orders, no recovery shall be effected against the petitioner pursuant to order dated 04.01.2025.

However, this interim order shall not preclude the respondents from filing any application under Article 226(3) of the Constitution of India.
