1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the accused-applicant submits that in this matter Nikhil Vardhan is one of the injured person and he is also the prime witness of the prosecution. Learned counsel further submits that the learned trial Court has called Nikhil Vardhan several times for recording of his evidence, but he has not appeared before the learned Tribunal for the same and furthermore, learned trial Court has also summoned him by issuing arrest warrants, yet, he has not appeared before the learned trial Court. Learned counsel further submits that the complainant is intentionally delaying the trial so that the accused-applicant remains in judicial custody for a longer time. It is, therefore, prayed that the benefit of bail be granted to the accused-applicant.

2. In support of his contentions, learned counsel has produced a copy of order-sheet dated 19.03.2026, by which learned trial

Court has summoned the injured witness-Nikhil Vardhan by issuing arrest warrants.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant submits that the next date of hearing before the learned trial Court in this case is 20.07.2026 for recording of evidence of injured witness-Nikhil Vardhan. Learned counsel further assures that, on the said date, Nikhil Vardhan shall remain present before the learned trial Court for recording of his evidence.
