1. The matter comes upon an application (IA No.1/2023) filed by counsel for the petitioner seeking amendment in the writ petition.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he has made two orders of same date i.e. 18.10.2014 as Annexure 2 & 3 but by an inadvertent mistake, he has placed on record the same orders as Annexure 2 & 3 and he seeks an amendment to place on record the other order dated 18.04.2020 as Annexure-3 in place on same order which has been attached by him.
3. As regard, this prayer is concerned, the respondent has no objection.

4. Counsel for the petitioner also prays that the other amendments which he wants to incorporate by way of amendment in the amended petition are the legal grounds in support of his claims.

5. Petitioner is always free to submit legal grounds orally in support of his claim and respondent has also no objection in regard to raising of legal grounds in oral arguments.

6. Considering the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as well as the counsel for the respondent, instead of allowing the prayer of the petitioner for seeking amendment in the writ petition, this Court deems proper to permit the petitioner to place on record the correct and relevant order dated 18.04.2014 as Annexure-2 and as regards legal grounds are concerned, petitioner is also free to raise the same during the oral arguments.

7. The Application (IA No.1/2023) is disposed off with the observations made above.
