Mrs. Smita Shrivastava (IPS), ADGP-Civil Rights and Mr. Shivraj Meena (IPS), SP-Civil Rights, Jaipur are present in the Court in compliance of the directions, which were issued earlier.

Learned State Counsel placed before us a report dated 07.12.2022 which contains the details of various circulars/directions, SOPs, mechanism, mode and methodology deployed to recover missing children. Along with the same, certain data has also been produced before us which we have perused. The report be filed on the record of the petition.

We are of the view that the efforts, which are being made to recover missing children, be made more effective, scientific and based on a detailed consolidated SOP based on due research and analysis. Additional Director General of Police, Civil Rights, present in the Court, would submit that as on the date, various data are being collected, which are being used by the machinery to make more effective recovery mechanism. We are of the opinion that there is a felt need of establishing a Research and Analysis Wing specially to make more effective child recovery mechanism in the State.

As was submitted before this Court earlier and we have also gone through various records placed before us, though large number of missing children have been recovered by now and the recovery is stated to be 95.70%, there are many cases like the present three cases, where the children have gone missing since long. Let all efforts be made to recover these children.

List these cases immediately after four weeks.

On the next date of hearing, learned State Counsel shall apprise the Court regarding establishment of Research and Analysis Wing attached to Children Recovery Unit at the State level and new/consolidated SOP, if any, prepared and issued by the State.

Presence of the Officers for the time being is exempted subject to the condition that they will have to remain present as and when directed.
