1. By way of filing the instant petition, a prayer has been made for issuing directions to the Investigating Officer for conducting fair and impartial investigation in the FIR No.286/2020, registered with Police Station Phagi, District Jaipur Rural, for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 447, 384, 452 IPC & Section 3(1)(s) & 3(1)(f) of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

2. It appears that before approaching this Court the petitioner has submitted a representation to the Police Officials with the aforesaid prayer and thereafter, since no heed was paid to the aforesaid representations therefore, the petitioner has approached this Court in the year 2020 and more than 6 years have passed,

thereafter, there is a possibility that after conclusion of investigation either charge-sheet or Final Report (Negative) may have already been submitted in the impugned FIR.

3. Without making any comments on the merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the instant petition, granting liberty to the petitioner to submit one more representation before the respondents for redressal of his grievances, in case such representation submitted by the petitioner, it is expected from the Police Officials to consider the same and pass appropriate orders strictly in accordance with law.

4. In case, charge-sheet has already been submitted or Final Report (Negative) has been submitted then the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies available to him under the law for redressal of his grievances.

5. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the instant petition stands disposed of. Stay application and all pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
