1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-applicant against the order dated 04.05.2026 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chaksu, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, Rajasthan in connection with FIR No. 30/2026 registered at Police Station Shivdaspura District Jaipur City (South) for the offences under Sections 115(2), 307, 140(3) & 189(2) of BNS, by which the bail application of the accused-applicant under Section 483 of BNSS has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that the accused-applicant has falsely been implicated in this case. Learned counsel further submits that the accused-applicant and complainant are relative to each other, the accused-applicant

Nawal Singh is *Mama Sasur* to complainant Kalu Ram. Learned counsel contends that an FIR was lodged for the offences under Sections 316(2), 85 of BNS, 2023 against the complainant by his wife-Sunita Meena, who is the daughter of accused-applicant Nawal Singh's sister, therefore, the accused-applicant is falsely implicated in this matter. Learned counsel further submits that charge sheet has been filed and the accused-applicant was arrested on 25.04.2026, and since then he is behind the bars. Learned counsel prays that trial will take considerable time to conclude, therefore, the accused-applicant may be enlarged on bail.

3. Learned Deputy Govt. Advocate vehemently opposes the bail application and submits factual report dated 31.05.2026 which is taken on record.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the facts that the accused-applicant and complainant are related to each other; that as per the factual report submitted by learned Deputy Govt. Advocate, charges levelled against the accused-applicant are for the offences under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 127(2), 140(3), 307, 3(5) of BNS, 2023; that the accused-applicant is behind the bars since his arrest dated 25.04.2026; that the offences levelled against the accused-applicant are triable by the Magistrate; that the trial of the case may take considerable time, therefore, without expressing any opinion upon merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it fit to enlarge the accused-applicant on bail.

6. Accordingly, the present bail application filed under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-applicant

Nawal Singh Son Of Shri Chauthmal, in connection with FIR No. 30/2026 registered at Police Station Shivdaspura District Jaipur City (South) shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two attested sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court. Accused-applicant is further directed to appear before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
