1. Considered Application No.01/2026 filed for early listing and
same stands disposed of.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner has filed application
No.01/2021 for disposal in light of judgment **dated**
22.02.2017 in SB CWP No.8162/2012 titled as Hajrai
Lal Vs. State and Ors. passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of
this Hon'ble Court and submits that writ petition be disposed
of in light of judgment as referred hereinabove.
3. Learned counsel for respondent has opposed the contention
and placed reliance upon reply submitted by him.
4. Having considered the submissions and material placed on
record, the issue raised herein is identical with already
decided in case of **Hajrai Lal Vs. State and Ors. (supra)**
