1. The instant bail application under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner in connection with the FIR No.34/2024, registered at the Police Station Sanganer, District Jaipur City (East), wherein he is charged for the offences punishable under Sections 8/21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no concern whatsoever with the alleged recovery. Counsel submits that the alleged contraband has been recovered at the instance of co-accused persons namely Harish Kumar Suman and Ajay Verma, who have already been granted indulgence of bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 01.02.2024 and there is no recovery at the instance of the petitioner and the

petitioner is in custody since 13.05.2026. Counsel further submits that the trial will take its own time to conclude, therefore indulgence of bail be granted to the petitioner.

3. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner.

4. Considering the arguments put forward by the learned counsel for the petitioner and looking to the fact that no recovery of any contraband has been effected at the instance of the petitioner, rather the contraband has been recovered at the instance of the co-accused persons namely Harish Kumar Suman and Ajay Verma, who have already been granted indulgence of bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 01.02.2024 and looking to the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 13.05.2026 and the trial will take its own time to conclude, hence, without expressing any opinion on merits and demerits of the case, I deem it just and appropriate to grant indulgence of bail to the petitioner under Section 483 BNSS.

5. Accordingly, the instant bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Rishi Sharma S/o Shri Purushottam Sharma** arrested in connection with aforementioned FIR, may be released on bail; provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- with two surety bonds of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of learned trial Court with the stipulation to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
