Petitioner moved an application (2/2025), seeking to implead the Secretary, Central Board of Secondary Education as party respondent.

The application has been moved by the petitioner after objection of the respondents in the reply, in respect of non-impleadment of Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), which is a necessary party in the instant writ petition.

Be that as it may, indisputably the CBSE is a necessary party to be heard and counsel for the petitioner submits that inadvertently, same could not be impleaded.

Accordingly, the application (2/2025) is allowed. Secretary, Central Board of Secondary Education is allowed to be impleaded as party respondent No.3 in the instant writ petition.

Let notice be issued to the Secretary, Central Board of Secondary Education.

In addition, copy of the writ petition be served in the office of Mr. M. S. Raghav, who usually appears on behalf of the Central Board of Secondary Education. Name of Mr. M. S. Raghav be shown in the cause list
