It is contended by learned counsel for the respondent that vide order dated 07.07.2023 (Annexure-R/1) passed by the Home Department, the petitioner's past service from 04.09.1987 to 14.10.1993 (about six years) has been added for granting him pensionary benefits and consequential benefits in pursuance to the order passed by the Rajasthan Civil Services Appellate Authority in Case No.2961/2001 dated 07.03.2007. Therefore, the respondents may be discharged from the contempt proceedings.

Heard and perused the order passed by the Rajasthan Civil Services Appellate Authority dated 07.03.2007.

Vide order dated 07.03.2007, it was directed to the respondents to add the petitioner's past service rendered in military and in compliance to the said direction, the respondents have passed order dated 07.07.2023.

Therefore, in the light of the above, the instant contempt petition is disposed of and the rule is discharged.
