Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that instant petitions are filed by the petitioner, who is an alumnus of the Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur. It is further submitted that proceedings against the petitioner were initiated under the NDPS Act read with provisions of Cr.P.C. Further, it is submitted that rejection of petitioners' objections regarding the mandatory

requirement of certification under Section 65B of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 is contrary to the settled position of law.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing for the respondents has submitted that the learned Trial Court has passed a speaking order after due application of mind. It is further submitted that instant matter is at fag end before the concerned Court. Moreover, custody period of 12 months in the NDPS matter, if the allegations are made out, is minuscule.
