Counsel for the parties submits that the issue involved in this writ petition has already been considered and decided by a Co- ordinate Bench of this Court in the matter of 'Jai Prakash Bhardwaj versus The State of Rajasthan' passed in D. B. Civil Writ Petition No.10504/2024 wherein on 11.07.2024 following order was passed:-

- "1. The controversy is regarding eligibility to the post of Hospital Caretaker.
2. The grievance of the petitioners are that even though they have possessed MBA/PGD (Two years regular course) in Hospital Management, the notification reflects eligibility only to require two years regular course, whereas the course undertaken by the

petitioners in open and distance learning mode is duly recognized as equivalent to MBA/PGD (Two years regular course) by the UGC as well as the Ministry of Education.

3. In view of the above, we are inclined to pass interim order in favour of the petitioners in the manner that the candidature of the petitioners for the post in question may be considered provisionally subject to the decision of the writ petitions.

4. Issue notice to the respondent(s) of the petition as well as stay application through ordinary process as well as by registered post. Rule is made returnable within eight weeks.

5. List this matter alongwith D.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 6454/2024 and other connected matters."

In that view of the matter, issue notice to the respondent(s), returnable by four weeks.

Shri Yuvraj Samant, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent-RPSC.

Office is directed to show the name of Mr. Yuvraj Samant, Advocate in the causelist.

List after four weeks.

Meanwhile, the candidature of the petitioner for the post in question may be considered provisionally subject to decision of the writ petition, if the process of selection is going on.
