Mr. Karan Tibrewal, learned counsel appears on caveat on behalf of Respondents No. 1 to 3. He prays for and is granted three weeks time to file reply.

Let copy of memo of appeal be supplied to Mr. Sandeep Taneja, learned Additional Advocate General who usually represents Respondent No. 4; Mr. Vigyan Shah, learned Additional Advocate General who usually represents Respondent No. 5 and Mr. Bhuvnesh Sharma, learned counsel who usually represents Respondent No. 6 within three days.

Names of Mr. Sandeep Taneja, Mr. Vigyan Shah, learned Additional Advocate General and Mr. Bhuvnesh Sharma, learned counsel be shown in the Cause List as counsel for respective respondents.

Let notice be issued to Respondent No. 7 on payment of P.F. within three days, returnable within three weeks.

In the meantime, taking into consideration the statement made at the bar by learned counsel for the parties that at present there are three vacancies of the post of Chief Engineer (E&M) in Respondent No. 6-Nigam, we are not inclined to stay review DPC which is to be convened in compliance of the order passed by the learned Single Judge. However, the appellant shall not be reverted and it would be open for the respondents to proceed to fill up vacancies other than the one occupied by the appellant.

List this matter after three weeks.
