1. Matter has come up on application (IA No.1/2025) for vacation of ex-parte interim order dated 03.07.2025 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.9661/2025 titled as *Manoj Kumar Tailor vs. The State of Rajasthan & Ors.* the interim order reads as under:

"In the meanwhile, one post of Nursing Officer in the OBC category, pursuant to advertisement dated 05.05.2023 shall be kept vacant, in case, as on date, vacant seat under such category is available."

2. The submissions raised in the stay vacation application relate to the veracity of experience certificate and entitlement to claim the bonus marks.

3. The submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the issue of experience certificate was considered by this Court in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.1201/2020 titled "*Manoj Kumar Tailor*

vs. The State of Rajasthan & Ors." in the first round of litigation, therefore, the stay order may not be vacated.

4. Since issue raised in the stay vacation application and germane question involved in the present writ petition are same, therefore, at this stage of the proceedings, without expressing any opinion upon the experience certificate and entitlement of the bonus marks, this Court finds no good ground to vacate the ex-parte interim order dated 03.07.2025 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

5. Accordingly, the application (IA No.1/2025) for vacation of ex-parte interim order is hereby dismissed.
