**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE RAVI CHIRANIA (V.J.)**

**Order**

**16/06/2026**

1. These misc. bail applications have been filed by the petitioners Mahaveer Singh @ Gullu S/o Panchu Singh, Deepak Singh S/o Mohan Singh, Jitendra Singh S/o Shri Narayan Singh, Vijay Singh S/o Shri Narsingh, Sanjay Singh S/o Shri Khet Singh, Ravi Singh S/o Shri Narayan Singh, Dinesh Singh S/o late Shri Beeram Singh, who were arrested by the police in connection with the FIR bearing No.183/2026 dated 21.05.2026 registered at Police Station Nasirabad Sadar, District Ajmer for the offence punishable under Section 303(2) BNS, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the bail applications filed by the petitioners were rejected by the Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge Nasirabad, District Ajmer vide order dated 29.05.2026, thereafter, the petitioners have

preferred these bail applications under Section 483 of B.N.S.S, 2023.

3. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners herein were arrested in connection with the allegation that they have stolen certain articles from the office of Power Grid Corporation (PSU Government of India). Learned counsel further submits that the recovery has been made, investigation is complete and there are no serious criminal antecedents against them. In view thereof, learned counsel prays that the petitioners may be enlarged on bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor strongly opposes the bail application, however, could not dispute the fact that articles have already been recovered and no more investigation is required.

5. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the present case and also that there are no criminal antecedents against the petitioners hererin, without commenting upon merits of the case, this Court is inclined to exercise its power under Section 483 B.N.S.S. and deems it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioners on bail.

6. Accordingly, these bail applications filed under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that accused-petitioners **Mahaveer Singh @ Gullu S/o Panchu Singh, Deepak Singh S/o Mohan Singh, Jitendra Singh S/o Shri Narayan Singh, Vijay Singh S/o Shri Narsingh, Sanjay Singh S/o Shri Khet Singh, Ravi Singh S/o Shri Narayan Singh, Dinesh Singh S/o late Shri Beeram Singh** shall be released on bail, provided they execute a personal bond in a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sound and solvent sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction

of learned trial Court for their appearance before that Court on each and every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till the completion of the trial. The petitioners are further directed not to take undue advantage of liberty or misuse liberty.

7. It is made clear that the observation as made by this Court in these bail applications will not affect the trial of the case.
