1. The present second bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Sultan @ Lalchand Son Of Hansraj** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.53/2025 dated 12.05.2025 registered at Police Station Ringas, District Sikar, for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 125, 119(1) and 352 of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant-accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the

applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that on basis of alleged incident in the evening of 11.02.2025 a report was registered by complainant against Lala Ram and others for extortion of Rs. 200. He submitted that present applicant was arrested and after investigation police has already filed a charge-sheet. He further submitted that the first bail application was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file after recording of injured- Kamlesh. He submitted that the statement of Kamlesh has already been recorded as PW-2. He submitted that present applicant-accused is in custody since 22.04.2025 and co-accused Vishnu against whom 11 criminal cases were registered was already granted on bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Hon'ble Court.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor and he submitted that the offence is serious in nature and role and involvement of applicant is established from the material on record.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of report registered by complainant- Mohan Lal on 12.02.2025 about incident of 11.02.2025 FIR No. 53/2025 was registered at Police Station Ringas, District Sikar. The applicant-accused was arrested on 22.04.2025 and police has already filed a charge-sheet. Till date two witnesses were already examined including PW-2 Kamlesh (injured). As

per police report 12 criminal cases were registered against the applicant, co-accused Vishnu was granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench on 31.01.2026 despite that 11 criminal cases were registered against him.

7. This Court also finds that the applicant-accused has remained in custody for a considerable period of time and that the trial/proceedings are likely to take further time to conclude. Therefore, looking to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Sultan @ Lalchand Son Of Hansraj**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.

(iv) The applicant-accused shall mark his presence on 2nd and 4th Tuesday at Police Station Ringas District Sikar.

The attendance be forwarded to the trial Court.

(v) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
