Both parties are ad idem that, during the pendency of the suit, the learned Trial Court recognized the plaintiff's right to use the passage over the disputed Khasra numbers.

They further agree that an easementary right has now been decreed in favour of the respondent-plaintiff, and that the status quo prevailing during the pendency of the suit ought to be maintained.

3. Accordingly, it is ordered that both parties shall maintain the status quo as it existed during the pendency of the suit. However, this order shall not prejudice or influence the First Appellate Court in deciding the appeal on its merits.
4. With the above observations, the present Civil Writ Petition stands disposed of.
5. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
