1. The present writ petition has been filed aggrieved of the action of the respondents whereby the petitioners have been discontinued from the post of Nursing Officer after the fresh recruitment process been undertaken in terms of Rajasthan Contractual Hiring to Civil Posts Rules, 2022.
2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that despite the recruitment process having been completed and the selected candidates having been appointed, several seats remain vacant till date. He makes a limited submission that the respondent be directed to consider the petitioners qua the said vacant posts keeping into consideration the fact that they had been working since the year 2024.
3. In support of his submission, Counsel relied upon a Co-ordinate Bench judgment of this Court in *S.B. Civil Writ Petition*

No. 13323 of 2026; Rama Kishan Badhaniya & Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors. (decided on 25.06.2026).

4. However, Counsel for the respondent-State submits that the petitioners have no locus to challenge the action of the respondents now, as the petitioners very well participated in the process undertaken. It is only after having failed to succeed in the said selection process that the present writ petition has been filed.

4. In view of the submission made, let the matter be listed tomorrow i.e. 01.07.2026.

5. Counsel for the petitioners shall complete his instructions regarding the fact - Whether the present petitioners participated in the process undertaken by the State Department in terms of Rajasthan Contractual Hiring to Civil Posts Rules, 2022 or not?
