1. This misc. bail application has been filed by the petitioner Ravindra S/o Syojilal, aged about 20 years, who was arrested by the police in connection with the FIR bearing No.169/2026 dated 18.05.2026 registered at Police Station Talera District Bundi for the offence punishable under Section 304(2) of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the bail application filed by the petitioner was rejected by the learned Sessions Judge, Bundi (Raj.) vide order dated 26.05.2026, thereafter, the petitioner has preferred this bail application under Section 483 of B.N.S.S, 2023.
3. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has stolen the bag of the complainant as mentioned in the FIR which contained important documents such as Aadhar Card, diary, etc. Learned counsel also submits that during the investigation, those stolen

articles have been recovered which further shows that there was nothing valuable in the bag. It is further submitted that no recovery is required to be made from the petitioner. In view thereof, learned counsel prays that the accused-petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor strongly opposes the bail application.

5. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the present case, the fact that recovery has already been made, no further investigation is required in the present case and without commenting upon merits of the case, this Court is inclined to exercise its power under Section 483 B.N.S.S. and deems it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail application filed under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that accused-petitioner **Ravindra S/o Syojilal** shall be released on bail, provided he executes a personal bond in a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sound and solvent sureties of Rs.50,000/- to the satisfaction of learned trial Court for his appearance before that Court on each and every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till the completion of the trial. The petitioner is further directed not to take undue advantage of liberty or misuse liberty. It is made clear that the observation as made by this Court in the bail application will not affect the trial of the case.
