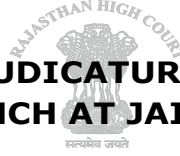

Order

1. No one is present on behalf of the petitioner. Earlier on 01.05.2026, when the case was called for hearing, no one appeared for the petitioner. On 18.11.2025, when the case was called for hearing, the petitioner sought time to complete instructions in light of the fact that, during the pendency of the criminal miscellaneous petition, the investigation had been completed and the charge-sheet had already been filed by the



Police Authorities. On 18.11.2025, the Court has also made it clear that no further adjournment shall be granted.

3. The present criminal miscellaneous petition has been filed by the petitioner for quashing the FIR No. 221/2016 registered at police station Hindaun, District Karauli, for offences punishable under Section 354 of the I.P.C. 1860, and in alternate, it has been prayed that the respondent be directed to change the investigation to some other Officer.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor submits that, after completion of the investigation, the charge-sheet was filed in the matter.

5. Taking into consideration the allegations against the accused-petitioner in the First Information Report and so also the fact that police after completion of the investigation has submitted charge-sheet in the matter, this Court is of the opinion that the present case is not a fit case for invoking its inherent jurisdiction.

6. Accordingly, this criminal miscellaneous petition stands dismissed.
