1. The present bail application has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 against the order dated 04.06.2026 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge Kaman, District-Deeg, in Criminal Misc. Case No. 819/2026, whereby the bail application of the petitioner was rejected in connection with F.I.R. No. 144/2026, Police Station-Kaman, District-Deeg for the offences under Section 13 of the Rajasthan Public Gambling Ordinances, 1949 & Section 112(2) of the BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation was only in respect to Section 13 of the Rajasthan Public Gambling Ordinances, 1949, in which the maximum punishment is fine and it is non cognizable offence. He further submits that falsely the provision of Section 112(2) of the BNS, 2023 have been invoked. He further submits that in the past, only

one case of similar nature has been found to be pending against the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that conclusion of investigation/trial will take sufficiently long time. Moreover, the offences are triable by Magistrate, therefore, he prays that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail as the accused is in custody since 25.05.2026.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the bail application.

5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.

6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and upon consideration of the submissions advanced, and particularly the fact that the allegation was only in respect to Section 13 of the Rajasthan Public Gambling Ordinances, 1949, in which the maximum punishment is fine and it is non cognizable offence; offences are triable by Magistrate; only one case of similar nature has been found to be pending against the petitioner; the conclusion of investigation/trial is likely to take sufficiently long time, this Court is of the opinion that the bail application deserves to be accepted.

6. Consequently, the bail application is **allowed**. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner namely **Raheesh S/o Subha Alis Jassu** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No. 144/2026, Police Station Kaman, District-Deeg, shall be released on bail; provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh Only) with two sureties of Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand Only) each, to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court, with the

stipulation that he shall appear before the said Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so until completion of the trial, subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The petitioner shall not leave country without the permission of the Court;*
- (ii) The petitioner shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected;*
- (iii) The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.*
