1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned charge-sheet has been served upon the petitioner on 29.05.2026, i.e. on the date of his superannuation. He submits that the same is clearly *mala fide*.

2. Further, the charge as framed, also a frivolous one.
3. In view of the submissions made, Issue notice.
4. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due.
5. Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.
6. Notices be made returnable in six weeks.
7. Meanwhile, further proceedings in pursuance to charge-sheet dated 29.05.2026 shall remain stayed.
