1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that vide impugned order/communication dated 29.05.2026, the services of the petitioners have been terminated on the pretext that the other incumbents have been appointed in terms of the Rajasthan Contractual Hiring to Civil Posts Rules, 2022.
2. Learned Counsel raised two fold arguments: firstly, the posts of Nursing Officers and Lab Technicians could not have been filled up in terms of Rules of 2022, as the said rules apply only to the posts qua which no regular service rules have been framed. Secondly, what has been sought to be done is the appointment of another set of contractual employees in place of the present petitioners who are also the contractual employees.
3. Admittedly, the process in question commenced in the month of January 2025 and after completion of the process, appointment orders have also been issued in favour of the incumbents in the month of May 2026.

5. In view of the above, let a copy of the writ petition be served on the Counsel who represents respondents No. 1 to 4, during the course of the day.
6. Notices be issued to respondent no. 5.
7. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due. Notices be made returnable within a period of three weeks.
7. Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.
8. List the matter after three weeks.
