Mr. Manvendra Singh, Adv. puts in appearance on behalf of
respondent No.1 and seeks some time to file *Vakalatnama*. His
name be shown in the cause list as counsel for the respondent
No.1.

Issue notice to the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 by both modes
i.e. by ordinary course as well as by registered post, returnable

within eight weeks. Requisites be filed within a period of one week.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant-Insurance Company submits that in this matter no FIR has been lodged by the claimant-respondent and the incident has not been investigated by the police. Learned counsel further submits that on account of injuries sustained by one- Jaswant Kumar due to collusion by the driver of the offending vehicle, the claimant-respondent preferred the claim petition before the learned Tribunal, whereby, vide judgment and award dated 10.04.2026 the learned tribunal allowed the claim petition and awarded an amount of Rs.2,50,000/- against the appellant-Insurance Company. Therefore, it is prayed that the effect and operation of the impugned award be stayed till pendency of this appeal.

The matter requires consideration.

Heard on stay application No.3005/2026.

In the meanwhile, the effect and operation of the impugned judgment and award dated 10.04.2026 passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal No.1, Bundi shall remain stayed.

Accordingly, stay application No. 3005/2026 stands disposed of.
