1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the inquiry for the same charges was conducted against two of the officials. So far as one of them is concerned, he preferred a writ petition being *S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.14742/2025; Harendra Kumar vs. The State of Rajasthan & Ors.* whereby interim order dated 26.08.2025 has been passed by this Court (at Jodhpur) in his favour.

2. Counsel submits that the present petitioner being identically placed, an interim order deserves to be passed in his favour.
3. Counsel further submits that a punishment of stoppage of three grade increments (without cumulative effect) has been imposed against the petitioner whereas it was established on record that the alleged 10 lakh blocks as manufactured were subsequently used by the State-Department and there was no monetary loss caused to the Department.
4. In view of the submissions made, Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also.
5. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due.
6. Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.
7. Notices be made returnable within a period of six weeks.
8. Meanwhile, effect and operation of order dated 04.11.2025 (Annexure-14) shall remain stayed.
