Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that the petitioner is a 61-year-old lady. It is contended that the only allegation against the petitioner is that she was a witness to the Power of Attorney executed in favour of her husband. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is neither a party to the said document nor a beneficiary thereunder. It is further submitted that merely because she is the wife of the co-accused, Madan, no criminal liability can be attributed to her in the absence of any specific role or overt act alleged against her. Considering the nature of the allegations, it is directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation and appear before the Investigating Officer on or before 30.07.2026.
