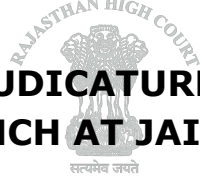

1. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners being aggrieved by the order dated 18.06.2026 (Annexure-1) issued by the respondent No.3 - Tehsildar, Singhana, District Jhunjhunu, vide which the petitioners have been directed to remove their encroachment upon Khasra No. 679 situated at Village Makro, District Jhunjhunu.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners are holding valid *patta* of the portion of land upon which they are residing i.e., of Khasra No. 679 and along with the residential houses several government buildings have also been constructed upon the said land and thus, the impugned notice could not have been issued.

3. Learned counsel further submit that considering the present prevailing status of Khasra No. 679, the Gram Panchayat itself way back in its meeting held on 15.08.2021, passed a resolution seeking the conversion of the said Khasra No. 679 from charagah to abadi. Learned counsel submits that as many as around 280

families have been residing at the said place for a long time, which is further substantiated by the electricity and water connections issued in favour of the petitioners.

4. Taking note of the above mentioned facts, issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks, both by ordinary as well as registered post. Notice be given "*dasti*" as well to the learned counsel to the petitioners.

5. Additionally, learned counsel counsel for the petitioners would also be at liberty to serve a copy of the petition in the Office of learned counsel who usually appears on behalf of the respondents.

6. List the matter on 29.07.2026.

7. Till then, further proceedings in consequence to impugned notice dated 18.06.2026 (Annexure-1) shall remain stayed.
