HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE ANUROOP SINGHI (V.J.)**Order****25/06/2026**

1. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners being aggrieved by the impugned communication dated 12.06.2026 (Annexure-1) issued by the District Collector, Sikar (respondent No.2) and addressed to the SDM Shrimadhapur (respondent No.3), in respect of the alleged encroachment upon *Khasra* No.68 to 74 situated at Village Rooppura-Udalwas, Tehsil Shrimadhapur, District Sikar, Rajasthan.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, Mr. Anurag Kalawatiya submits that the petitioners and respondents No.4 to 7 are already entangled in a dispute *qua* the very same land as respondents No.4 to 7 have already preferred a suit before the Assistant Collector (Fast Track), District Shrimadhapur (Neem Ka Thana), titled as *Mishri Devi & Ors. Vs. Bhagirath @ Ors.*, wherein an interim order to maintain status quo *qua* Khasra No.68 to 74 has already been passed on 15.10.2024.

3. Mr. Manoj Choudhary, appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 submits that the communication dated 12.06.2026, though has been issued, only calls for a report and it nowhere directs to dispossess the petitioners and thus, there is no occasion for the petitioners to approach this Court at this stage.

4. Taking note of the above mentioned facts, issue notices to the respondents, both by the ordinary process as well as the registered post, returnable within six weeks. As the appearance has already been made on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, service stands complete. Notices be filed for respondents No.4 to

7 which may be given "*dasti*" as well to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. Taking note of the order dated 16.10.2024, whereby directions to maintain status quo *qua* Khasra No.68 to 74 have already been passed and further submission made by learned counsel appearing for respondents No.1 to 3 that no action for dispossession is proposed to be taken against the petitioners, it is directed that respondents No. 1 to 3 shall not take any coercive action against the petitioners in pursuance of the communication dated 12.06.2026 (Annexure-1) *qua* the land in dispute.

6. List the matter on 11.08.2026.
