1. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner, being aggrieved by the order dated 16.06.2026 (Annexure-1) passed by the First Appellate Authority under the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 2012, whereby the appeal filed by respondent No.3-Lead Guard Service Private Limited, was allowed and the Experience Certificate submitted by the petitioner was held to be invalid.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Banwari Lal Sharma, at the very outset submits that the work order was issued in favour of the petitioner by respondent No.2 on 27.05.2026 (Annexure-5) itself, which was well within the knowledge of respondent No.3. However, despite that, in the appeal filed by it, the petitioner was not arrayed as a respondent, more so when any decision in the said appeal would have directly affected the rights and interest of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel further submits that the impugned order dated 16.06.2026, holding the Experience Certificate of the petitioner to be invalid and as a consequence, adversely impacting the work order issued in its favour, could not have been passed behind its back.

4. Learned counsel submits that as the illegality goes to the root of the matter and has been committed in gross violation of the principles of natural justice, the present petition has been filed.

5. Taking note of the above mentioned facts, issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks, both by ordinary as well as registered post. Notice be given "*dasti*" as well to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. List the matter on 29.07.2026.

7. Till then, the effect and operation of the impugned order dated 16.06.2026 shall remain stayed.
