1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that impugned charge-sheet dated 23.01.2026 (Annexure-3) has been issued by the Collector, who is neither the appointing authority nor the disciplinary authority of the petitioner, who is serving as a Medical Officer. Learned counsel submits that the charge-sheet deserves to be quashed, having been issued by an incompetent authority.
2. In view of the submissions made, Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also.
3. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel

for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due.

4. Postal receipt of the '*dasti*' notice be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notice.
5. Notice be made returnable within a period of six weeks.
6. Meanwhile, further proceedings pursuant to charge-sheet dated 23.01.2026 (Annexure-3) shall remain stayed.
7. However, the respondent authorities shall be at liberty to withdraw the aforesaid charge-sheet and proceed against the petitioner in accordance with law, if so desired.
