1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order impugned dated 24.03.2026, the services of the petitioner have been terminated whereas it was the specific case of the Managing Director himself that the alleged sale of submersible pumps had been undertaken by the Federation at Kota. So far as the Federation at Jhalawar is concerned, no documents pertaining to

the said sale were available. In support of his submission, Counsel relied upon communication dated 22.05.2026 (Annex.8) of the Managing Director of Jhalawar District Milk Producers Cooperative Federation Ltd. Jhalawar.

2. In view of the submission made, Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also.
3. Counsel Mr. Siddharth Lamror accepts notice for respondent no.1. Let a copy of the writ petition be served on him during the course of the day. He may file reply by the next date.
4. Notices be issued to the other respondents and be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due.
5. Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.
6. Notices be made returnable within six weeks.
7. Meanwhile, effect and operation of orders dated 24.03.2026 and 28.03.2026 (Annexure-7) shall remain stayed.
