Heard on the application No.01/2024 filed on behalf of the petitioners with the prayer for issuing directions to the respondents to permit the petitioners for joining of their duties in compliance of the order dated 31.01.2020 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 31.01.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioners submitted various letters to the respondents for their joining, however, they were not allowed to join their duties.

Mr. R.N. Mathur, Sr. Adv., assisted by Mr. Rajpal Dhankar appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that no physical joining has been given by the petitioners in compliance of the order dated 31.01.2020 passed by this Court.

In that view of the matter, We direct the respondents to allow the surviving petitioners to join physically their duties in



compliance of the order dated 31.01.2020 passed by this Court in the Office of the Chief Manager, Jaipur Depot of RSRTC, Chomu House, Pariwahan Marg, Jaipur within a period of seven days from today.

It is made clear that if the respondents do not allow the surviving petitioners to join physically their duties, then, the Chief Manager, Jaipur Depot of RSRTC, Chomu House, Pariwahan Marg, Jaipur shall remain present in the Court.

Office is directed to send a copy of this order to the Chief Manager, Jaipur Depot of RSRTC, Chomu House, Pariwahan Marg, Jaipur for necessary compliance.
