1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order impugned dated 24.06.2026 (Annexure-6), the petitioner has been directed to be given a non-field posting on the pretext that an inquiry in terms of Rule 16 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Classification, Control And Appeal) Rules, 1958 (for brevity 'the CCA Rules') is undergoing whereas the said inquiry had already been stayed by the Department itself vide order dated 02.07.2025 (Annexure-4) as the effect and operation of the adverse comment made against the petitioner in order dated 01.10.2024 had been stayed vide

order dated 23.05.2025 passed in S.B. Criminal Misc. Petition No.2791/2025.

2. In view of the submission made, Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also.
3. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due.
6. Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.
7. Notices be made returnable within a period of six weeks.
8. Meanwhile, the effect and operation of order dated 24.06.2026 (Annexure-6) shall remain stayed.
9. However, if the Department decides to re-commence the proceedings under Rule 16 of the CCA Rules, it would be at liberty to pass appropriate orders.
