1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that it is only after order dated 09.02.2026 passed by the Court in the earlier writ petition (S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.2523/2026) filed by the petitioner that the Appellate Authority has proceeded on to decide the appeal as preferred by the petitioner vide order dated 06.03.2026. He submits that the said order is a total non-speaking one and no reason whatsoever has been assigned for rejection of the appeal.
2. Counsel further submits that the petitioner had been in service since the year 2009 firstly, as a casual labour and subse-

quently on contractual employment since the year 2016. The said long services of the petitioner had been terminated without assigning any reason and now the appeal too has been dismissed without assigning any reason.

3. In view of the submissions made, Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also.

4. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due.

5. Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.

6. Notices be made returnable within a period of six weeks.

7. Meanwhile, the respondents shall permit the petitioner to perform his duties.
