1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order impugned,
a punishment of stoppage of 1 grade increment (without
cumulative effect) has been imposed against the petitioner and
because of the said punishment, his name is not likely to be
considered for promotion in the upcoming DPC. Counsel while

relying upon a Co-ordinate Bench judgment of this Court at Jaipur in **Raghuveer Singh Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors; S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 20358/2018** (decided on 07.05.2024) submits that the petitioner deserves to be considered for promotion irrespective of the order for punishment.

2. In view of the submission made, Issue notice.
3. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due.
4. Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.
5. Notices be made returnable in six weeks.
6. Meanwhile, if the DPC is convened, the petitioner shall be considered for promotion irrespective of the order of punishment, if otherwise eligible.
