Order

14/07/2026

1. Petitioners have filed the instant writ petition with following prayers:

"It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that your Lordships may please to accept and allow the Writ Petition and by an appropriate writ, order or direction:-

1. The entire record relating to this case may kindly be called for and after perusing the same direct the respondents to enter the name of Petitioners in the revenue record for agricultural land bearing Khasra numbers 1679, 1680, 1681, 1683, 1684, 1678, belongs to Sadhu, Surja S/o Tota as sub tenant Village Basdi, Tehsil Kotputli, Distt. Kotputli-Behror, (Rajasthan) in their name also entered in Revenue Record as per their respective possession.

2. By any other appropriate writ, order or direction if any order prejudice to the right of the Petitioners which may be passed during the pendency of the Writ Petition may also be declared null and void being without jurisdiction and be quashed and set aside and name of the Petitioners be entered in Revenue Record as entered in similarly situated persons as per directions of the Hon'ble Court in the in the Judgment dated 30.03.1993 passed in S.B. C.W.P. No. 1878/1982 Iswar Vs. State and the compliance of the order has been made by the Respondent.

3. Any other order or direction which this Hon'ble Court deems fit may also be passed in the facts and circumstances of the case."

2. At the outset, learned counsels for both the parties jointly submitted that similar controversy has already been examined by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.9158/2026 (Bhomaram & Anr. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.)** decided on 21.05.2026, wherein following directions were given:

"7. Looking to the overall facts & circumstances of the case and considering the submissions made at bar, the present writ petition stands disposed of with a

direction to the petitioners to approach the respondents by filing a fresh application for conferment of their right and the respondents are directed to decide the said representation/s in accordance with law.

8. In case, the petitioners file representation/s within a period of two weeks, the same may be decided by the respondents in expeditious manner but in no case later than six weeks from the date of receipt of the representation/s."

3. In view of above consensus arrived at between the learned counsels for both the parties, the present writ petition also stands disposed of in the same terms and with the same directions as granted by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the case of **Bhomaram (supra)** decided on 21.05.2026.

4. Pending application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
