Learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner after investing the huge money has established the ATS (Automated Testing Station) and the respondent/s have also issued the preliminary registration certificate on 31.08.2023 for a period uptill 28.05.2024, which was thereafter extended up to 29.02.2024 vide letter dated 21.03.2024.

Learned counsel further submits that after getting an audit, the petitioner had submitted its detailed report and all other required updated formalities, but the respondent/s, in an illegal and arbitrary manner, instead of granting the RC to the petitioner, have invited applications for issuing the PRC to other persons.

Learned counsel also submits that there are in all five vacancies and the respondent/s, instead of granting the

registration certificate to the petitioner, have invited applications for allocating five PRCs and have granted five PRCs.

Mr. Bhart Vyas, ASG appearing for the respondent-State prays for and is granted two weeks' time file reply.

Till further orders, the respondent/s shall keep one vacancy for the petitioner for issuance of the registration certificate for an ATS.
