1. S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 27951/2018 is filed with following prayer:-

It is, therefore, prayed that this writ petition may kindly be accepted and allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction, the respondents may kindly be directed to regularize the petitioner's services from the date of his initial appointment and accordingly grant the pay scale of Rs.9300-34800 with grade pay of Rs.3600/- to the petitioner on completion of 9 years service and accordingly revise his pay scale, selection scales as also the pension and the arrears whereof be also paid to him with interest at rate of 12%.

2. S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 12400/2022 is filed with following prayer:-

- i) An appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondents for declaring that the petitioner shall be entitled for grant of 3rd Selection Scale w.e.f. 15.07.2009 on completion of 27 years (i.e. counting service prior to the date of absorption i.e. 16.07.2002) in supersession to the earlier order dated 09.05.2014 (Annex-11) whereby petitioner was granted w.e.f. 16.07.2012 with grant of all consequential fixation, revision of Grade Pay w.e.f. 01.07.2013 and fixation under Rules of 2017 until his date of retirement alongwith payment of arrears and interest thereon @9% p.a.*
- ii) An appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondents for grant of interest @9% p.a. w.e.f. 01.01.2018 till the date of actual payment i.e. 21.05.2018 on all belatedly paid retiral benefits as per Rule 89(1) of the Pension Rules, 1996 along with consequential relief.*
- iii) An appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondents for revision of all retiral benefits on the basis of newly arrived LPC after grant of*

prayer No.(i) alongwith payment of arrears with interest @9% p.a.

iv) An appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondents quashing any adverse order, if passed, during pendency of the writ petition frustrating the case of the writ petition.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that the issue involved herein is no more res integra and stands resolved by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 12.04.2017 in case of **Rajkumar Agarwal Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors.: S.B. CWP No. 5400/2015** and by a Division Bench of this Court in **D.B. Special Appeal Writ No.1232/2019** titled as **Girdhar Gopal Jagrawal Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.** decided on **19.04.2021**. She further referred order dated **24.10.2024** in **S.B. CWP No. 12238/2018** titled as **Sudhindra Kumar Sindhava Vs. State of Rajasthan and Ors.** and submits that the issue has already been considered and followed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents admit the fact as mentioned by learned counsel for petitioners.

5. Having considered aforesaid, the writ petitions are disposed of in terms of judgment dated 12.04.2017 in case of **Rajkumar Agarwal Vs. State of Rajasthan (supra)** and judgment dated 19.04.2021 in case of **Girdhar Gopal Jagrawal Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors. (supra)**.

6. Necessary compliance be made within a period of 12 weeks from date of communication of this order, failing which, the arrears shall carry interest at the rate of 6% from the date of 20.05.2022.

7. The writ petitions and misc. application, if any, stands disposed of.
