1. An additional affidavit has been filed on behalf of the petitioners with an averment that petitioner Nos.1, 2 & 3 have been working with the respondent Department since three decades and petitioner Nos.4 & 5 have been working for last about two and half decades.
2. In the earlier writ petitions filed by the petitioners for the relief for regularization, respondent Authorities were directed to decide the representations of the petitioners but no action has been taken till date.
3. Now, the services of the petitioners are sought to be terminated on the pretext that regular employees are to be appointed.
4. In view of the submissions made, Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also.
5. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel

for the petitioners for service through registered post acknowledgment due.

6. Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.
7. Notices be made returnable within six weeks.
8. Meanwhile, the services of the petitioners shall not be terminated.
