Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the prayers asked for in the writ petition are honored, and the children of the petitioner are given admission in the Army school, and are thereby regularly attending the classes. It is submitted that qua the prayer for restricted entry in the Army premises, the same was also considered and appropriate sanctioning/permission cards are issued.

It is also submitted that as on date, a divorce decree is passed qua the petitioner, thus, in light of the changed circumstances, the question which now arise is whether the petitioner falls under the definition of 'dependent'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has opposed the said submission and has submitted that the children of the petitioner are being denied access to school and seek education.
